

2012 Event Details – ‘The Turning’

SpearHead runs a mixture of day and weekend long live-roleplay events in and around the south of England. This form can be used to book for ‘Turning’, the third showpiece event of our new campaign ‘The Murk’.

All events are suitable for new and existing club members. Event style tends to be gritty high fantasy within a rolling campaign.

The SpearHead Club have been running events since 2002. Continuing at this event, The Murk campaign tells the tale of the human nations and cultures of the Terran Ocean. The Turning event is an exciting opportunity to influence the new campaign and to shape the path of the story. In-character the event will be hosted by the Icen and Thanir nations.

‘The Turning’ – 18th to the 20th May 2012 – Stanford Scout Camp, near Gatwick.

The event will run from the evening of Friday 18th May until the afternoon of Sunday 20th May. The site is wooded with a mixture of clearings and forest with flushing toilets and showers. Accommodation for players and crew will be camping. All will need to provide their own tents.

Themed meal on Saturday evening is included within the event price. Catering over the weekend will be provided by Caterporium - www.caterporium.com. An optional meal ticket costing £15 covers all of the rest of the meals throughout the weekend. Meal tickets are to be bought in advance through this booking form.

Players Event Price:

Player booked before 1st February 2012 - £60

Player booked before 7th May 2012 - £70

Player booked after 7th May 2012 or paying on the gate - £80

Events are written and tailored to suit the characters of the booked players. The event team can offer guidance and advice in creating new characters to suit the style of event. Players are asked to read the Campaign Guide and specify the nation they wish to base their character from and either indicate this on the booking form or email bookings@spearheadlrp.co.uk Players will then be sent a Nation Guide relevant to their choice.

Crew Event Price:

Crew space – Free if booked in advance. £10 on the gate

We ask that all crew book in advance as they will be written individual roles. Crew for all events will receive ‘credits’ that are redeemable at other SpearHead events. Conditions apply. Crew able to arrive on Thursday 17th May and help with set-up will receive an additional credit.

In addition to the normal ‘Play’ or ‘Crew’ option, for this event we are also offering the choice of ‘Either’. Either spaces are limited in number; please contact us to check they are still available. Those that book as ‘Either’ get a discounted rate but agree to part play / part crew. Those booked as Either will be allowed to play their chosen character but also commit to crewing for approximately three hours across Friday and Saturday, and will crew all of Sunday.
